Cheryl Connors provided a delegation with respect to Staff Report 2020-0016: Proposed Zoning By-law Amendment – James Dick Construction Limited (Erin Pit Expansion), Ward 1. Ms. Connors stated that in her opinion there this is a cumulative impact of aggregate activities on the neighbouring environment. She expressed concerns with respect to health impacts of the application and the air quality study produced. Ms. Connors concluded her delegation stating that in her opinion the studies completed did not provide information relating to the social impacts of the proposed application. She submitted photographs for the public record depicting the accumulation of dust on her property from the existing aggregate pit.

Cheryl Connors provided a delegation with respect to Proposed Regulatory Changes Under the Aggregate Resources Act. Ms. Connors expressed concern with the lack of social impact being considered under the proposed regulatory changes. She identified health and air quality concerns that she has experienced living in close proximity to an aggregate pit. She requested that a committee be formed to review the regulations and prepare recommendations and responses to the Province that take into consideration the social impacts of residents.

1. Neighbourhood Information Tool

Sandra Solonik, Advisor, Community Engagement, Region of Peel and Chine Nkado, Manager, Business Intelligence, Region of Peel provided a presentation regarding the Neighbourhood Information Tool. Mr. Nkado advised that the development of the Neighbourhood Information Tool aligns with the Town of Caledon's Council Work Plan and referenced the Region's strategic priorities. The tool was developed to ensure data could be viewed consistently throughout the Region. Ms. Solonik provided a demonstration of the tool and indicated that the majority of the data is census based. The tool is designed to be a snapshot of data and overtime, users will be able to compare the data from previous years.
