To ensure that the standard is still effective in prioritizing high energy performance facilities, a review cycle was built into the procedure.</li> <li>The CGBS update will apply to all new Townowned facility construction and major renovations.</li> </ul>	Q1 2020 – Q4 2020
Net Zero Emissions Study	<ul> <li>This study will develop a plan to bring an existing facility to net zero emissions.</li> <li>The Town will join a cohort of municipalities to complete this study through the Climate Challenge Network (formerly the Mayors Megawatt Challenge) and leading experts, consultants and researchers to develop a net zero design brief that will lay out the costs and technical specifications for the studied Town facility.</li> </ul>	Q2 2020 – Q1 2021
Corporate Green Fleet Strategy	<ul> <li>Transportation represents the second largest source of corporate emissions (42%). The Town has a target to reduce corporate transportation related emissions by 30% below 2017 levels by 2024.</li> <li>A significant strategy to achieve this, is the development of a Corporate Green Fleet Strategy, to closely examine and model the Town's existing fleet uses and identify, prioritize and create the business cases for lower carbon options that can be undertaken with fleet asset renewal.</li> </ul>	Q2 2020 – Q1 2021
Waste Audit and Retrofit Projects	Complete the waste audit and retrofit project at the Caledon Centre for Recreation and Wellness and begin the waste audit and bin replacement at the Caledon East Community Complex.	2020 – 2021*  *note this timeline has been impacted due to COVID-19
