BY-LAW NO. 2020-64

A by-law to amend COVID-19 Mandatory Face
Covering By-law 2020-47 to extend the date the by-law
is to be repealed

WHEREAS on July 7, 2020, Council for The Corporation of the Town of Caledon ("Council") enacted the COVID-19 Mandatory Face Covering By-law 2020-47 (the "Face Covering By-law") to require face coverings in indoor spaces and vehicles accessible to the public;

AND WHEREAS based on the advice of the Medical Officer of Health for the Region of Peel received September 8, 2020, Council is desirous to amend the Face Covering By-law to extend the requirement for residents to wear face coverings in indoor spaces and vehicles accessible to the public to continue to reduce the transmission of COVID-19;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Section 26 be amended by deleting the date "October 30, 2020" and adding the date "January 31, 2021".

Enactment

This By-law shall come into full force and effect on the day of its passing.
