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What is an Age-Friendly Community?

The World Health Organization (WHO) defines an age-friendly community as one that is "inclusive and accessible urban environment that promotes active aging"

- Age-Friendly communities deliver POLICIES, PROGRAMS, SERVICES and SPACES that help residents maintain their independence as they age.
- When communities provide the appropriate policies, programs and services for Older Adults — there are cascading benefits for residents of all ages.
- Age-Friendly communities provide Older Adults with the tools they need to live safely, enjoy good health, and stay actively involved in their community.








Caledon is Taking Action Now

- The number of older adults (55+) in Canada now exceeds the number of youth.
- Between 2021 and 2031, persons age 55+ will represent one of the fastest growing segments of the population. Caledon is forecasting an additional 10,000 residents over the age of 55 by 2031.
- This Plan is intended to ensure that the Town of Caledon and its community partners are fully prepared to meet the needs of an ageing population base.
