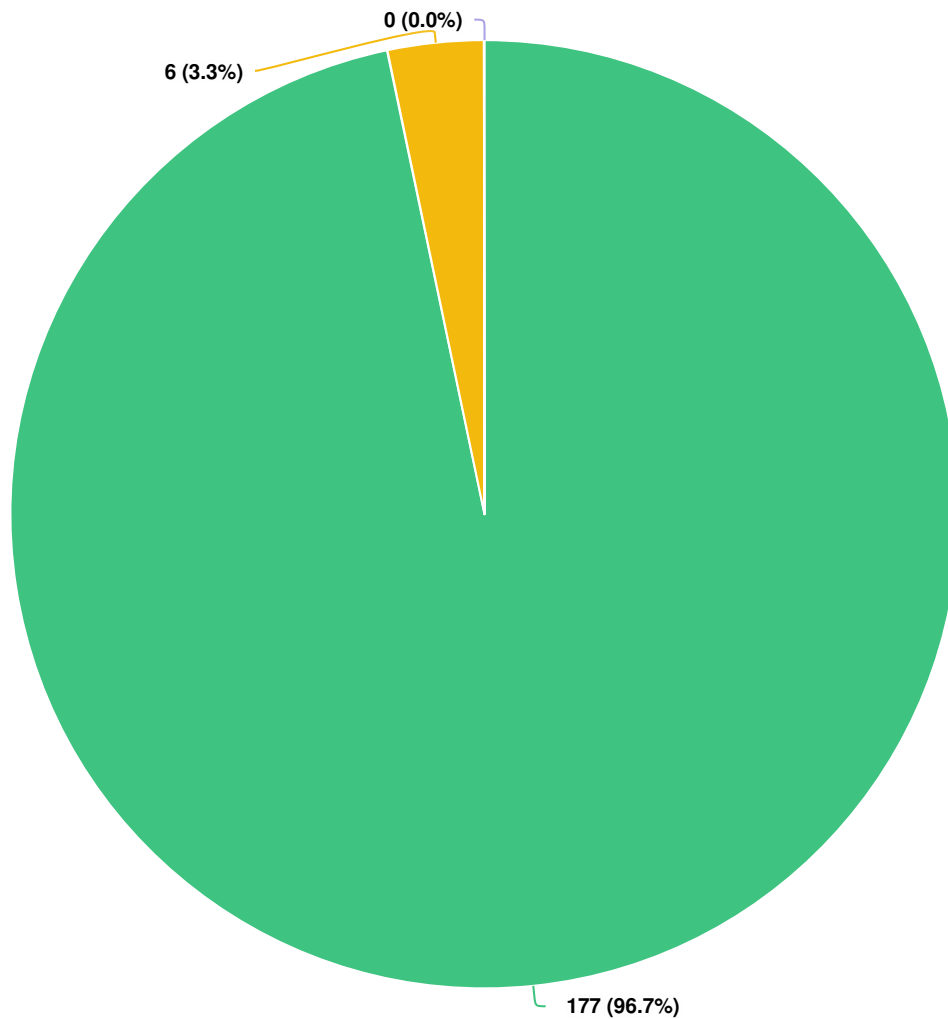

**Q3** Will you be an eligible voter for the October 24, 2022 Municipal and School Board election?

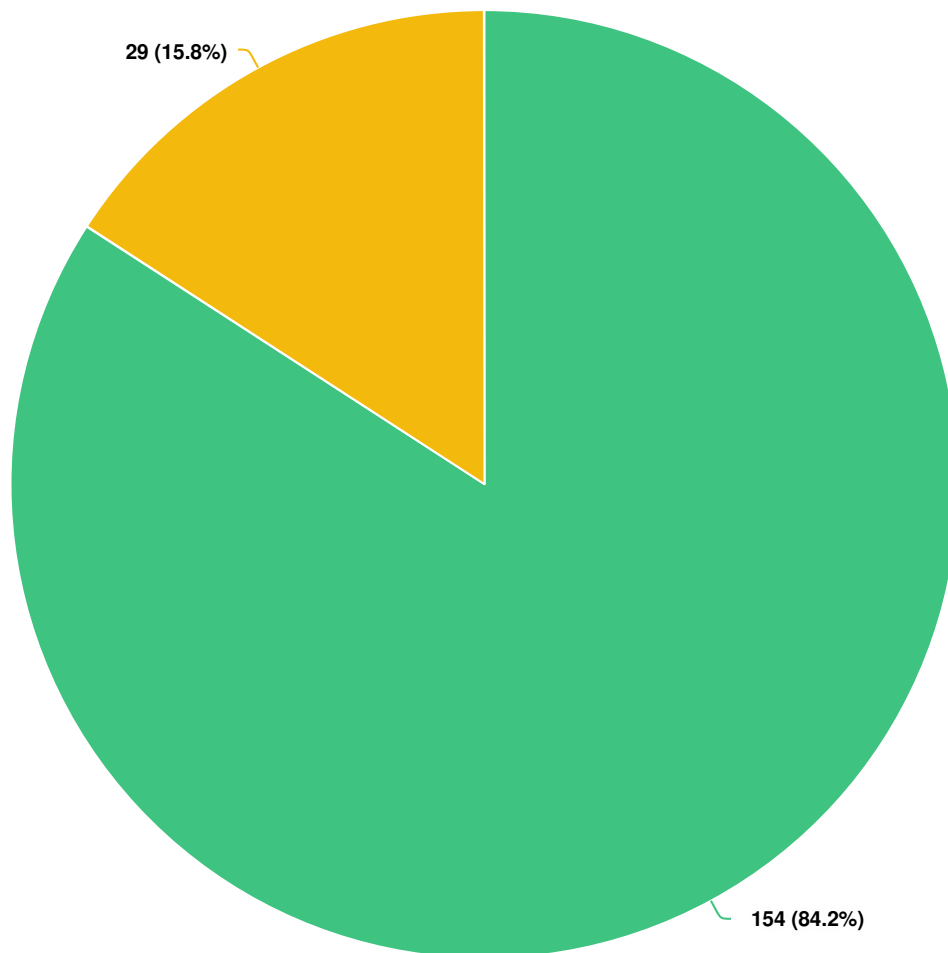

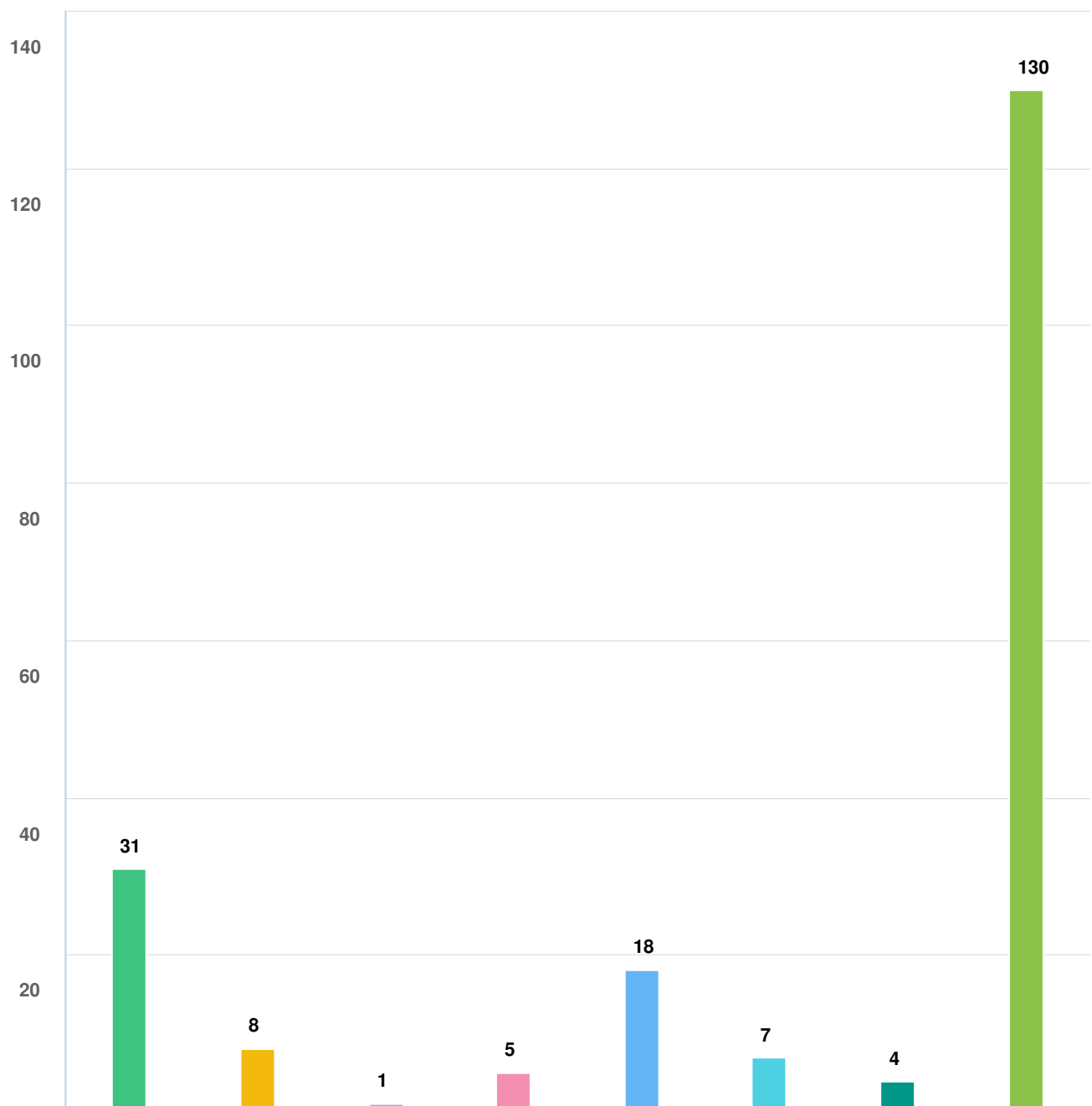
