

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CALEDON

BY-LAW NO. 2022-XX

A By-law to authorize the use of voting and vote-counting equipment for the 2022 Municipal and School Board election and repeal By-law 2017-7

WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched.*, as amended, provides that the Council of a local municipality may pass a By-law authorizing the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon considers it desirable to implement an in-person physical ballot voting method for the 2022 Municipal and School Board election;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon hereby authorizes the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders and optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes for the 2022 Municipal and School Board election.

Repeal

- 2. By-law 2017-7 shall be repealed.
