




Purpose of my Presentation





Collective challenge

Town of Caledon

• 2030: ↓ GHG emissions 36% below 2016 levels

2050: Reach net zero GHG emissions

 - ICI Efficiency











Centre for Community Energy Transformation: Governance



- Phased approach to governance with a volunteer skills-based Board for strategic oversight
 - Transitional Board (currently recruiting volunteers)
 - Permanent Board
- Stakeholder Advisory Committee to provide support to Board
- Compliment of 5 staff for day-to-day management and operations


Centre for Community Energy Transformation: Funding & Partnership



- Recommended CCET will require \$1 million/year
- Phased approach to funding:
 - Start Up 2022
 - \$300,000 grant from City
 - Region of Peel grant formal discussions pending
 - Operation 2023 to 2026
 - Service Level Agreement with City
 - Additional Service Level Agreements with:
 - Region of Peel
 - City of Mississauga
 - Town of Caledon
 - Federal and Provincial funding
 - Energy Service Fees
 - Sponsorship

Next Steps

- Continue to engage in conversation with Caledon & Mississauga through the Project Advisory Team
- Continue partnership with Caledon, Brampton and Mississauga on the design of a home retrofit program for Peel Region (funded through FCM)
- Commence work with Caledon and Mississauga on costing and scope of a potential Service Level Agreements with CCET
