CURRENT SPEED LIMIT IS 60 KM/HR

DIRT /GRAVEL ROAD  
NO SIDEWALKS  
FREQUENT SCHOOL BUS STOPPING  
NUMEROUS BLIND SPOTS  
FREQUENTLY MUDDY OR ICY  
ONLY A MATTER OF TIME

INSTALL NO STOPPING SIGNS ALONG  
BOSTON MILLS ROAD  
FROM HWY 10 TO AIRPORT ROAD





## SOLUTION #2 REDUCED SPEED LIMIT

REDUCE SPEED LIMIT FROM  
60 KM/H  
TO  
40 KM/H
