






Rejected to Serve in Military due to Racism

Camp Sussex, N.B. November, 25th 1915.

From O.C. 104th O.S. Battl.C.E.E.

To A.A.G. 6th Division,

Halifax, N.S.

Discharges 104th O.S. Bn. C.E.F.

Sir,-

I have the honor to request that you will approve of the discharge of the men mentioned in the attached roll, and also approve of thetransportation of these men to St John, N.B.

These men were hegroes, and I rejected them on the grounds that it would be against the interest of the Battalion to have them; also the interest of good discipline.

I have been fortunate to have secured a very fine class of recruits, and I did not think it was fair to these men that they should have to mingle with negroe.
