

Town of Caledon Residents Petition Regarding Municipal Enforcement Capabilities

Attention Sylvia Jones:

The undersigned residents of Caledon would request that the provincial government immediately table legislation that allows municipal governments to act swiftly in the face of blatant disregard for municipal bylaw infractions. These infractions can present a safety, health or environment risk if not immediately dealt with. In many cases, perpetrators simply view long drawn out court proceedings and insignificant fines as a cost of doing business and ignore municipal enforcement requests. Providing municipalities with greater enforcement capabilities to shut down blatant violators, such as illegal trucking yards in Caledon, will save valuable municipal resources and be a deterrent for this type of activity. Precedence has already been established in the enforcement of illegal marijuana dispensaries that opened in Toronto where the municipality had the capability of immediately shutting locations down and proceeding with charges.
