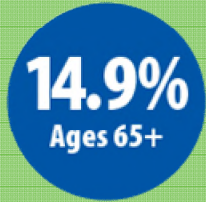
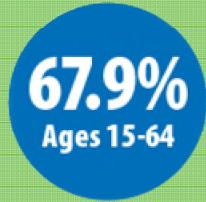
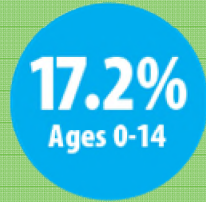

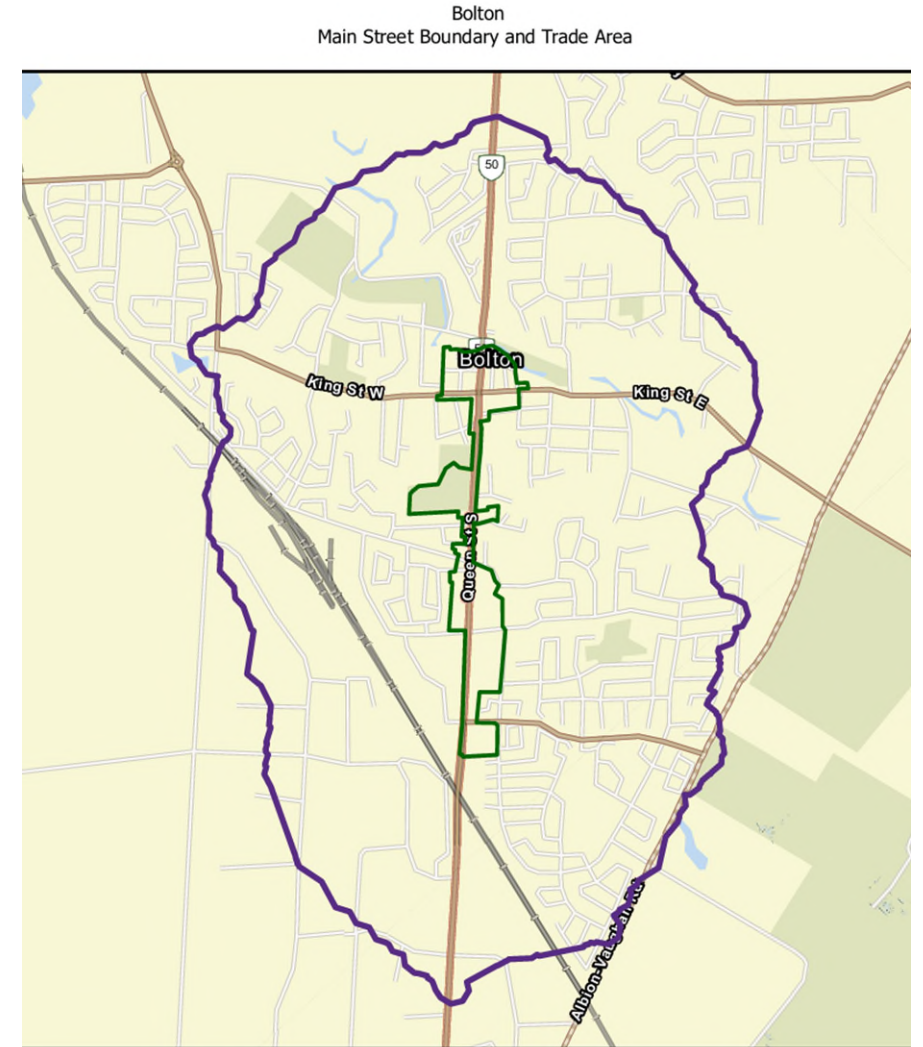

Over 500 people engaged directly with an additional 60 individuals engaged at focus groups and meetings with equity-representing organizations



Findings

- 423 post-it notes written by community speaking to their vision for a Caledon where people of all backgrounds feel represented
- Of 423 post-it notes, 195 post-it notes mentioned that Caledon is an amazing place to live because of a feeling of community and comradery amongst neighbors
- Of 423 post-it notes, 230 spoke to the bounty and beauty of Caledon's green spaces
