In accordance with Section 88.34 (8) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, the Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee, within 30 days after receiving Staff Report 2023-0374: Town Clerk's Report on Contributors Who Appear to Have Contravened Contribution Limits Pursuant to Section 88.9 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* – Gaetano Franco, shall consider the report and decided whether to commence a legal proceeding against the contributor for an apparent contravention.

The meeting will be conducted in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act* and the Terms of Reference for the Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee.

Where the contributor and/or the candidate, or their respective representatives, are not present at the meeting, the Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee may proceed in their absence and they are not entitled to any further notice.

Meetings of the Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee are open to the public and any information and documents which are presented to the Committee will be received and form part of the public record. If there is any information that you do not wish the Committee to receive and to form part of the public record, state your concerns at the start of the meeting and the Committee will decide whether or not that information shall be received and kept as confidential. In accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, despite the meeting being open to the public, the Committee may deliberate in private.

The contributor and candidates are subject to the requirements of the *Law Society Act* with respect to who may appear on their behalf as a representative.

The Municipal Elections Compliance Audit Committee will decide whether to commence a legal proceeding against a contributor for an apparent contravention.
