

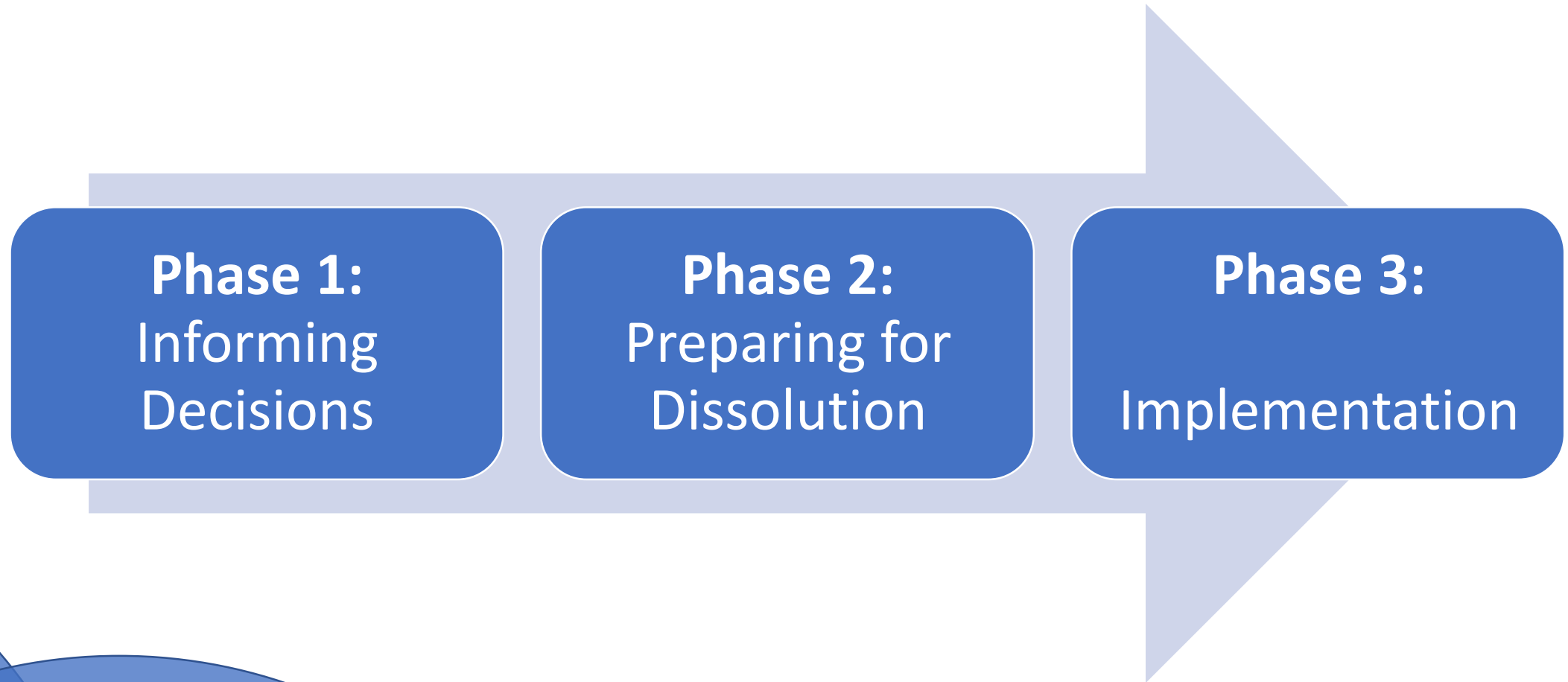
Background

- *The Hazel McCallion Act (Peel Dissolution)* was passed on June 9, 2023. The legislation:
 - Calls for the dissolution of Peel effective January 1, 2025
 - Enables the province to appoint a board to facilitate the dissolution process
 - The Transition Board was appointed on July 5, 2023
 - Kick-off meeting with the Transition Board took place October 17, 2023
- 

Role of the Transition Board

- Transferring assets; assigning liabilities, debt and other financial obligations of Peel
- Managing employment matters
- Facilitating decisions on the allocation, governance, use and control of services provided by Peel
- Providing recommendations that ensure the long-term economic sustainability of the Brampton, Caledon and Mississauga as single-tier municipalities

Transition Process

Phase 1: Informing Decisions

Purpose:

- Increase understanding of the services, assets, future plans and present concerns regarding 12 identified service buckets.
- High-level redistribution of services
- Initial discussion on employment matters

Timeframe:

Nov 2023- Jan 2024

Transition Process

Phase 1: Informing Decisions

Work Effort:

- Weekly core team meetings
- Biweekly working group meetings for 12 service buckets
- 5-7 days turnaround for research and analysis
- Monthly critical milestone meetings
- Significant demand on legal and financial expertise

Service Buckets:

- Water and Wastewater
- Waste Management
- Land Use Planning
- Human Services
- Health
- Housing
- Transportation
- Regional Policing
- Paramedics
- Labour Relations
- Heritage, Arts and Culture
- Information Technology

Phase 2: Preparing for Dissolution

Purpose:

- Detailed discussion on how assets and liabilities will be redistributed
- Draft Report prepared

Timeframe:

Jan - May 2024

Work Effort:

TBC

Transition Process

Phase 3: Implementation

Purpose:

Implementation of recommendations will be determined by the Ministry.

Timeframe:

TBD

Dissolution in effect January 1, 2025
