Subject: Request for an OPP Community Sub-Station in Bolton

PROCEDURAL PROCESS:

In accordance with Section 8.10 of the Procedure By-law being By-law 2015-108, as amended, Notices of Motion shall be in writing and delivered to the Clerk by the agenda deadline, to be included on the agenda for consideration at the scheduled Committee Meeting.

MOTION:

Whereas Bolton within the Town of Caledon is the most densely populated area of the entire community; and

Whereas the Council of the Town of Caledon is desirous of enhancing safety within the entire Town of Caledon including Bolton; and

Whereas a visible police presence in the form of Policing Detachments, Policing Sub-Stations, or Community Stations serve as a powerful crime deterrent within the adjacent areas; and

Whereas a dedicated police presence in Bolton would also serve to deter the instances of illegal trucks operating in the area; and

Whereas the Peel Regional Police have been highly successful in the past in adopting Police Sub-Station models in our partner municipalities of Brampton and Mississauga within Peel; and

Whereas there previously was a community station in Bolton;

Therefore be it resolved that Council directs staff to formally request that the OPP prepare a report with a presentation for a November 2024 meeting detailing the financial costs associated with establishing a OPP Community Sub-Station with foot-patrol in Bolton to be established in 2025; and

That this request for an OPP Community Sub-Station in Bolton become a part of the 2025 budget process.
