## Brampton Airport Zonina Requlations

#### **ECONOMIC VALUE**

- Privately operated non-profit
- Annual operating surplus
- 90 BFC employees = 70 FTE
- \$10.8M annual revenue (2023)
- \$105K tax contribution (2023)
- \$4.1M in capital investment since 2018

- Restaurant









### **ZBA Application RZ 2025-0001**

- Overlay to existing Caledon Zoning By-law 2006-50
- No new development proposed
- **Height Limit Provisions** 
  - Applies to structures and natural growth
  - 3D surfaces include:
    - Approach/Take-Off Surfaces
    - Transitional Surfaces
    - Outer Surface

### **ZBA Application RZ 2025-0001**

#### Land Use Provision to address wildlife hazards

- Limit land uses hazardous to aviation – including things that attract birds, such as:
  - Landfills,
  - Dumps,
  - Stormwater retention ponds,
  - Etc.
- Amendment or minor variance provision





## 2015


Application process started in 2016 with a written request to Transport Canada.

## 2017

Presentation was made to Council outlining the process and requirements to implement Airport Zoning Regulations.

## 2019

- Caledon Staff Report 2019-013 recommends that the Mayor and Clerk enter into the necessary agreement with Transport Canada to initiate the process.
- Commitment Agreement between Town of Caledon and Transport Canada was signed by Mayor Thompson in January 2019.





## 2021


Agreement template was subsequently amended by Transport Canada and re-issued.

2019 - 2023

Caledon, Brampton Flying Club, and WSP collaboratively developed the Draft By-law between 2019 and 2023.

2024 - 2025

- Revised Agreement was prepared and submitted to Transport Canada for review and approval. This Agreement was signed by Caledon and Transport Canada in 2024.
- PARC Meeting in June 2024 to brief town staff on the pending application and Zoning By-law Amendment Application RZ 2025-001 was submitted in December 2024 and deemed complete for circulation in February 2025




