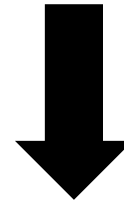

Caledon's Policies

**Mineral aggregate operations to be prohibited
where Air Quality Assessment shows PM_{2.5} level
in excess of 5.0 µg/m³ annual average**

From Caledon staff memo:

“Ministry staff shared a draft decision with Town staff...”

“The Minister’s decision regarding the Future Caledon Official Plan and OPA 1 will be final.”

What Municipalities can do:

**Adopt more detailed or prescriptive policies than
Provincial Policy (can't directly conflict)**

Ontario Land Tribunal ruling:

**Provincial Plans are “minimum standards” and
municipalities can implement more stringent standards
appropriate to their community.**
