BY-LAW NO. 2019-71

A By-law to amend By-law 2016-106, as amended, being a By-law to delegate certain powers and duties to officers and employees

WHEREAS Sections 23.1 and 23.2 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorize a municipality to delegate certain powers and duties;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon enacted By-law 2016-106 on December 20, 2016, being a By-law to delegate certain powers and duties to officers and employees;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon passed By-law 2019-43 to regulate the care and control of animals within the Town and considers it necessary to amend the aforesaid By-law to provide for a process through which variances to its provisions may be granted;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Caledon ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Delegated Authority By-law 2016-106, as amended, shall be further amended by repealing and replacing Schedule C as attached.
